

Yukon is ahead of most provinces and territories in several energy efficiency policies and benchmarks. Here is a snapshot.

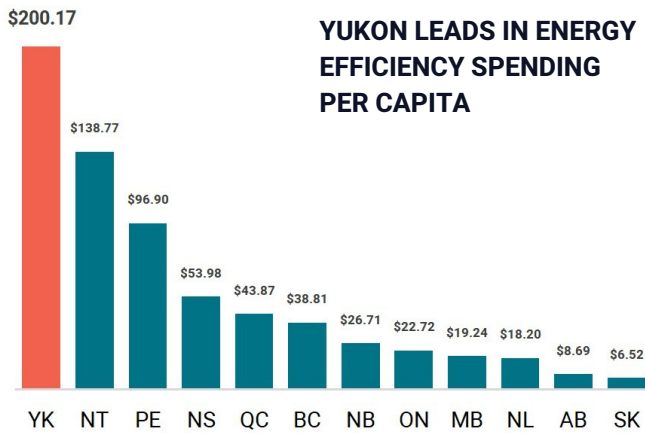


Figure 1. Energy efficiency program spending per capita

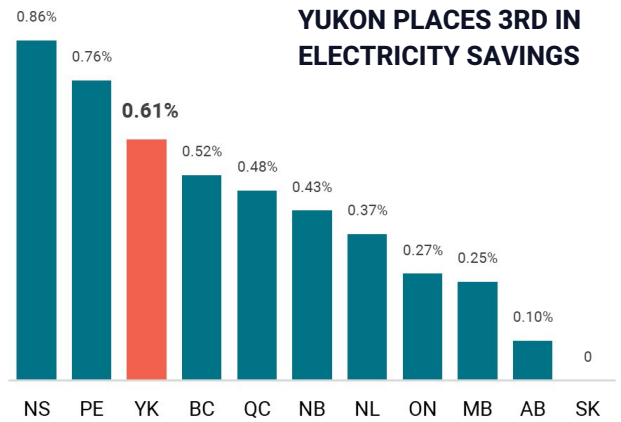


Figure 2. Net annual incremental electricity savings as a percentage of domestic sales



NOTE THAT:

- Savings were held back by a regulatory ruling disallowing Yukon Energy to administer energy efficiency programs. These results were achieved through government programs only. Yukon Energy was granted “leave to appeal” this decision in July 2020
- Savings in Yukon may not be as rigorously evaluated as most provinces



YUKON IS ALSO FURTHER AHEAD ON BUILDING CODES THAN SEVERAL PROVINCES:

- Whitehorse requires large buildings to adopt latest building code (2017 National Energy Code for Buildings) & new homes regulated under the Building and Plumbing Bylaw and receive EnerGuide rating
- Plus, aspiration to see all new buildings be net zero energy ready by 2032
